These 2 cycle routes follow the same path in Belgium. Are you looking for the perfect combination of nature, sea and culture? EuroVelo 4 - Central Europe Route, and EuroVelo 12 - North Sea Cycle Route will still your hunger for new sights along the Belgian coast. Meander along the beach with a view of the sea, pedal through the dunes and woodland and explore vast areas of the polders' flat landscapes. On the way, discover the rich history of the sea life along the 10 seaside resorts along the Belgian coast.



Meuse Cycle Route

In a gorgeous setting with incredible cliffs and a scattering of spectacular châteaux, the route follows one of the most beautiful river valleys in Europe. This journey through Wallonia could be called the "Citadel Way" because it gives you the opportunity to discover Dinant, Namur, Huy and Liège. There's not a car to be seen in Flanders, purely picturesque places like the most beautiful village in Flanders: Oud-Rekem. Here the Meuse rules everything, as evidenced by the parts of the river being so wild, no one can navigate it.



Pilgrims Route

Imagine you're a pilgrim and discover the variety of landscapes from the highly significant "Trois Frontières" where Germany, Belgium and the Netherlands all meet, to the bright, green wooded countryside of the Pays de Herve region. Also discover the unique post-industrial heritage along the Sambre river, which is unique to Europe, before enjoying the relaxing atmosphere of the rural landscapes of the Haute Sambre. And above all, you can't miss out on discovering the cultural diversity within Wallonia and its cities such as Namur, Charleroi and Liège.



Via Romea Francigena

An unmissable route for you to discover! Experience woodland scenes along the green routes by the canals, the river Scheldt, the river Dender and the river Meuse. Make the most of the calm trails, picturesque locks, wild and natural parks, from the Pajottenland to the Belgian Ardennes. Conquer the Sonian Forest, discover the European capital of Brussels, and even Namur and Dinant. Become a true cycling legend by climbing the Grammont Wall!

Can you easily take the train with your bike?

Yes, you can travel on all Belgian trains by paying an additional bike cost of €4. Check out the BikeOnTrain app, which will help you find the best train to travel with your bike.

Where can I eat and sleep, and what should I visit?

Find places marked as "Bienvenue Vélo" or "Bed&Bike" in Wallonia, "Bike Friendly" in Brussels, or accommodation certified "Logies op maat van vakantie fietsers" in Flanders. These accommodations, tourist sites, restaurants, tourist information points, etc. have equipment and special services specifically set up for cyclists (repair kits, water bottle refills, etc.)»



Are the routes signposted?

Yes, all of the international and regional routes are signposted in both directions.






Iconic cycle routes



Vennbahn

The Vennbahn is one of the most beautiful long routes that you can cycle along an old railway track. It crosses three countries: Germany, Belgium and Luxembourg. The 125 km route has an average elevation gain of only 2%, and travels from Aachen to Troisvierges, via the High Fens. On your journey, you can discover the nature and charm of the border regions, and stories surrounding the Vennbahn and its rich history.
